About Us:

Development Perspectives is a development NGO that explores, examines and acts upon a range of issues and challenges that face our world. It is essentially a development education organisation that aims to involve people in the local and global development process.

The Role:

In September 2015, the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development was adopted by UN Member States. Central to the Agenda is the set of 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) which define a plan of action for people, planet and prosperity to be undertaken by all countries until the year 2030.

As we move into our third year of the agenda, the SDG Challenge is a global development education project set up in 2016, which aims to raise awareness of the SDGs and empower action towards their achievement (<https://www.developmentperspectives.ie/SDGChallenge/index.html>). In order to continue to grow this exciting project we are currently seeking an individual to undertake a six month, part time internship.

Key Tasks:
