

About 33% of world soils are moderately to highly degraded. 40% these degraded soils are in Africa and other areas that are afflicted by poverty and food insecurity.






Every year, <u>13 million hectares of forests are los</u>t. The persistent degradation of drylands has also led to the desertification of 3.6 billion hectares, disproportionately affecting poor communities

Wildlife populations have declined by on average 69% in the past 50 years.






Mountains provide 60-80% of all freshwater resources for our planet. At least half of the world's population depends on mountain ecosystem services to survive – for water, food and clean energy. At least 600 mountain glaciers have disappeared completely over the <u>past few</u> decades alone.









The Atlantic salmon, European eel and angel shark have suffered catastrophic population declines, and the freshwater pearl mussel, Ireland's longest living




