
Unemployment Rate % (Aged 15-74








The Doughnut **Economics:** definition and critical analysis

A DOUGHNUT? ARE **NE REALLY TALKING** (Wagner, 2022)

Inclusive and Sustainable Growth:

Economic development should be designed to avoid both social deficits (falling short on life's essentials) and ecological overshoot (exceeding planetary boundaries).

SDG 8 and Doughnut Economics:

Doughnut Economics provides a framework for achieving this goal by ensuring that economic growth happens within a sustainable and equitable space.

The Doughnut Model:

Safe and just space for human prosperity, with an inner ring representing the social foundation (meeting basic human needs) and an outer ring representing the ecological ceiling (planetary boundaries).





